## Nurse's Niche

From the Nurse's Office:

Dear Parents,

As the end of the school year approaches, here are a few reminders in preparing for the end of the year.

If your child has prescription or over the counter medications at the nurse's office, please plan to come by and pick them up. 8<sup>th</sup> graders should have all medications picked up by Thursday May 22, 2008. Kindergarten thru 7<sup>th</sup> graders should have medications picked up by April 30, 2008. St. Charles School policy is to dispose of any remaining medications and accessories over the summer. Many of these medications are quite costly, so please plan to come in to retrieve these medications.

If your child needs medications at school, you can pick up the medication form and complete it over the summer with your primary care provider. You can turn it in for when school begins in the fall. If you have questions come in and ask for which type of medications this form is needed.

Summertime is a good time to take care of immunizations needed for school. An update on the Tetanus vaccination is required for entry into the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, if there has been at least five years since the last tetanus update. Please also note that if you have an incoming kindergartener the New Mexico Department of Health is now requiring a second dose of varicella to enter school.

In these last three weeks of school remember to send your child to bed early. Please ensure that they are eating a healthy breakfast also. Also, send a water bottle with your child to school so your child can keep up with their daily allowance of water. The days are getting hotter and they need this extra boost to get through these last few days of school.
